

## Procedures Guide for 2022 Master's Degree Candidates: Submission of "Request for Examination of Master's Thesis" and "Application to Continue to Doctoral Program in Medical Science for 2023"

\*This document is to assist international students to process their master's thesis submission and application to continue to Doctoral Program in Medical Science, Graduate School of Medicine, Kyoto University. The students must consult their supervisor to confirm the documents prior to submission.

### 1. "Request for Examination of Master's Thesis" and "Application to Continue to Doctoral Program"

#### (1) Submit the "Request for Examination of Master's Thesis" with Thesis Title

Fill in the designated Form1 ("Request for Examination of Master's Thesis (学位論文審査願; Gakui Ronbun Shinsa Negai)" and submit (\*)

① **Deadline: 17:00, Tuesday, November 29, 2022**

② **Submit to: Office of Student Affairs (1st floor, Building C)**

\* "Thesis Title" and "your wish for continue to the doctoral program in Medical Science" must be sent by email at the same time of form submission. For details, refer to the Form 1.

#### (2) "Application to continue to Doctoral Program"

Those who wish to continue to Doctoral Program in Medical Science, Graduate School of Medicine, Kyoto University must submit in the designated Form 2 ("Application to Continue to Doctoral Program (進学願; Shingaku Negai)" and Research Protocol (Free format/1 page in A4 size/ Both English or Japanese can be accepted)

① **Deadline: Friday, November 25, 2022**

② **Submit to: Professor/Chief supervisor of your Research Field**

## 2. Submission of Master's Thesis

### (1) Word processing format (for both Abstract and Main Body)

- A4 size, Portrait mode, MS word (or any text software), Horizontally (from left to right)
- Keep the 2.5cm margin around the text area
- Font size: 10.5pt - 12pt
- Font type: Times New Roman (in English) / MS Mincho (in Japanese)
- About 550-650 words per page in English (About 35-40 characters per line, 35 lines per page in Japanese)
- Page number of the Main Body must be put lower on center bottom

### (2) Booklet style

The booklet must be combined in the order described as follows.

[1] Cover page: Refer to the sample on the right. Use the MS MINCHO font, except for your name and name of Research Field (department) as they have to be written in MS GOTHIC.

[2] Abstract of Thesis: Within 1 page/A4 size

[3] Main Body: Within 10 pages/A4 size

This part must be page-numbered. Paper which has been already published in a journal cannot be substituted for the Master's Thesis, though such paper can be attached to the thesis as a reference.

[4] Acknowledgment: Add if that is a joint research. Re-number pages.

[5] Reference Papers: Re-number pages.

[6] Figures: Re-number pages.

- Keep them to the minimum necessary.
- They must be put in the order of "Figure legends", then "Figures and Tables".
- You may put colored Graphs, figures, tables. But they must be clear and judicable as supplementary explanation.

### (3) Text Composition

[1] Introduction: Background, aim, and motivation, etc.

[2] Methods: Describe simply about the method of experiments.

[3] Results: Conclusion that follows directory from the data of the experiments, analysis and results.

[4] Discussion: Interpreting the data of experiments, discussion and pointing problems. Outlook of the future research.

#### (4) Supervisor Guidance

The thesis must be reviewed under your supervisor's guidance.

#### (5) Number of Copies

1) Abstract: A4/ 1 page ----- 1 copy

\* The first line must be "Title of thesis (論文題目)" and the second line must be "Master's Program in Medical Science Entrance Year XXXX, Name (name of research field (department)) (「医科学専攻修士課程令和○○年度入学 氏名(研究分野)」)" in MS Gothic font.

\* This abstract is for the attendance of "Master's thesis oral presentation and examination". It must not be taken out of the venue.

2) Master's Thesis Booklet: A4 / Duplex (double-sided) Printing  
/ Stapled on the top left corner) ----- 4 copies

\* 3 copies are to be distributed to the members of the examination committee board as confidential documents and 1 copy will be kept in the Graduate School of Medicine.

3) Notification of Research Integrity Tutorial ----- 1 copy

\* For applying a degree, taking a research integrity tutorial conducted at each laboratory is compulsory. The form of Notification of Research Integrity Tutorial is available below:

### 3. Master's Thesis Oral Presentation and Examination

Master's Thesis Oral Presentation and Examination will be conducted by each Graduate Courses for Integrated Research Training (GCIRT) . The details including the date and place will be announced later.

#### 1) Examination time and method

①Time: Oral presentation 15 min + Q&A 15 min = 30min maximum

②Method: Applicants must show their student ID card to the judges before starting the presentation. Oral presentation should be made by MS Power Point in principle.

③Examination for Doctoral Program: The applicants of Doctoral Program in Medical Sciences will have some extra Q&A as an entrance examination.

④Others: Applicants **must bring their student ID card** for identification, or they cannot take an examination.
